IGS Annual Scientific Meeting President's Welcome

Professor Rose Anne Kenny

Dear Colleagues,

You are all very welcome to our first virtual Annual Scientific Meeting.

We have had a tremendous response from members with respect to abstract submission and received in excess of 240 abstracts. On this occasion we employed 20 external reviewers, all of whom have academic appointments and experience. We have identified 181 abstracts for publication in Age and Ageing and applaud the high quality and diversity of submissions.

We are looking forward to our two keynote lectures. The first of which will be from Professor Donna Fick who is the Elouise Ross Eberly Professor in Penn State University and Director of the Centre of Geriatric Nursing Excellence. Donna was proposed by Dr Niamh O'Regan. Donna's area of research expertise is the care of older adults, medication use in older adults, and delirium superimposed on dementia. She is widely published and has extensive experience in the field of cognitive ageing, particularly in the context of delirium. Her lecture is entitled 'Celebrating All Older Adults: **Delirium Detection and Management** in Age-Friendly Care'.

A keynote lecture will also be delivered by Professor Joe Verghese who is the Professor of Neurology and Medicine and Director of the Resnick Gerontology Centre at the Albert Einstein University. Joe is widely published and well known in the field of gait disorders and his research covers the effects of disease

and ageing on gait and cognition in older adults including the influence of cognitively stimulating activities on reducing risk of dementia, mobility loss, cognitive control of mobility and global health. He is more recently published on a new motoric cognitive risk syndrome and the title of his keynote will be 'Motor ways to Dementia'.

We very much look forward to both of these public lectures.

The purpose of the Irish Gerontological Society is to primarily to promote education and training in gerontology. The majority of our members are medical practitioners, but there is also a good representation of other healthcare practitioners.

During the year we have compensated for the lack of ability for any face to face meetings with intense on line education and training programmes which were initiated by my predecessor Professor Diarmuid O'Shea. These have proven highly successful and popular and I thank all of you who have been involved in chairing or managing these.

We have also started a programme of new public lectures. These have also been remarkably successful with over 5,000 registrations for the first public lecture. We plan to continue these quarterly.

Since our last meeting we have appointed a new part time administrator, Julie Carr and I would like to take this opportunity to thank our prior administrators, Miriam Ahern and Mai Olden for their years of excellence service to the organisation.

Our sister organisation, the ISPGM, is supporting an essay competition for medical students which will be awarded in honour of the memory of Professor Michael Hyland whose legacy to geriatric medicine on this island is remarkable and who many of us our initial interest and passion for this specialty. He worked tirelessly to support a topic area which at the time was very much a Cinderella subject. He was held in huge esteem by clinical colleagues in what was then St Finbarr's Hospital and now University College Cork teaching hospital ably supported by his first consultant colleague, Professor Cillian Twomey.

The award aligns well with the current intervarsity medical school Dr. Jack Flanagan CPC competition which is being hosted under the stewardship of Dr Paul McElwaine by Tallaght University Hospital/Trinity College Dublin this year.

Donna M. Fick

Elouise Ross Eberly Professor; Director of the Center of Geriatric Nursing Excellence Penn State University

Dr. Fick is nationally and internationally recognized as a leading expert in geriatrics and is best known for her work on delirium superimposed on dementia. She co-authored the American Academy of Nursing (AAN) executive summary for early detection of cognitive impairment, led two Choosing Wisely statements for the AAN and served on the panel for the AGS Guideline for Postoperative Delirium in Older Adults that was published in 2014. She recently completed two randomized intervention R01 level studies to decrease the duration and severity of delirium superimposed on dementia. These studies were funded by the National Institute of Health and together have generated more than 13 publications. Her current NIH study is an MPI study funded by the NIA with MPI Edward Marcantonio, MD with the Harvard School of Medicine that is testing an ultra-brief screening tool (UB-2) and two step delirium identification process for delirium with clinicians and over 450 older adults. Her area of research has focused on two critical issues in the care of older adults, medication use in older adults and delirium superimposed on dementia (DSD). She is a member of the interdisciplinary panel for the American Geriatrics Society Beers Criteria (AGS) for inappropriate medication use in older adults, and serves on the American Geriatrics Society Board. She has co-chaired the Beers Criteria since 2001. This criteria for drugs to avoid in older adults is widely used in practice and the 2003 release has been cited over 2,700 times. The criteria were recently updated in 2018 and she once again served as Co-Chair on this update with Todd Semla and Mike Steinman. She also serves as an expert faculty member and coach on 'Creating an Age Friendly Health System Initiative' funded by the John A. Hartford Foundation and led by the Institute of Healthcare Improvement. Dr. Fick was a past member of the NAS/IOM Committee on the Public Health Dimensions of Cognitive Aging, which released a report in 2015 on Cognitive Aging, and she currently serves on the National Academy of Sciences, Engineering and Medicine Forum on Aging, Disability and Independence.

Dr. Fick widely disseminates her work through over 100 publications, national media coverage, national and international presentations, as well as through her work with the John A. Hartford Foundation. She has been Editor of the 'Journal of Gerontological Nursing' since 2011. Dr. Fick received her BSN from Berea College, her MSN from the University of Cincinnati, and her PhD from the University of California, San Francisco. She served as a Visiting Professor at the Aging Brain Center, Institute for Aging Research, Hebrew SeniorLife, and an affiliate of Harvard Medical School from 2013-2014. She is ANCC board certified as a Gerontological Clinical Nurse Specialist through 2019 and is a Fellow of the American Academy of Nursing.

Dr. Verghese is Professor of Neurology and Medicine, Murray D. Gross Memorial Faculty Scholar in Gerontology, and Director, Resnick Gerontology Center at Einstein. He is the Chief of the Integrated Divisions of Cognitive and Motor Aging (Neurology) and Geriatrics (Medicine).

His area of research is disease and aging on gait and cognition in older adults; influence of cognitively stimulating activities on reducing risk of dementia and mobility loss, cognitive control of mobility, and global health Dr. Joe Verghese graduated from St. Johns Medical College, Bangalore, India in 1989. He did his postgraduate training in internal medicine and Neurology in United Kingdom. He completed his Neurology residency at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine, Bronx, NY in 1998. He did his fellowship training in Neurophysiology as well as Aging & Dementia in 1999 at the same institution. He received a Master of Science degree in Clinical Research Methods with Distinction in 2001. Dr Verghese is board-Certified in Neurology.

Dr. Verghese is a recipient of the Beeson award from the National institute on Aging and the Outstanding Scientific Achievement for Clinical Investigation Award from the American Geriatrics Society. His research interest is the effects of disease and aging on mobility and cognition in older adults. He has over 200 peer-reviewed publications and several federally funded grants in this area. His current projects include studying the influence of cognitively stimulating activities on reducing risk of dementia, the role of divided attention tasks such as walking while talking in predicting outcomes such as disability and cognitive decline, cognitive interventions, and global health.
